Read the following sentences about the narrator and her life.
Choose the correct statements and justify them by quoting the text.

b) An empty house was not a problem for her in the past.

I.5: "There was a time when coming back to an empty house would fill me with pleasure."

I.5-7: "I'd luxuriate in the extra, unexpected bonus of having the place to myself, and happily breathe in the peace and quiet."

e) She considers new technology as a religion for people.

I.12-13: "all bowed as though in prayer"

ou

I.13: "worshipping their BlackBerries and iPhones"

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I.13-14: "the rosary of the text message"

f) She is ashamed not to be connected to the outside world.

I.15-16: "It's a mark of shame not to have any friends, real or virtual, no followers, not to be linked in to everyone you ever met for five minutes – once – at a party in 1974."

<u>This is a lie.</u> In this humorous comment, the journalist actually means that <u>he could not do without technology</u>. He has just convinced himself that <u>new technology can make a holiday easier</u> and <u>more enjoyable</u> for him. He feels <u>reassured and less guilty</u>.

7. The journalist uses 3 expressions: "tech sabbath" (line 1), "unplugged excursion" (line 2), "digital detox" (line 27).

Link these key ideas to express the journalist's initial intentions. (30-40 words)

As he was a <u>tech addict</u>, he felt he had to <u>sever all links</u> with technology and to be <u>weaned off his use of digital devices</u>. He set himself the <u>challenge</u> of spending a week <u>without resorting to any electronic devices</u>. (41 words)
