

Yesterday, Ruth Lawrence came first out of the 530 candidates who took the entrance exam for St Hugh's College Oxford. The college is going to offer her a scholarship - pay for her education. Ruth took three-hour papers - Algebra, Geometry and statistics. "I was happy with the first two." she said yesterday, "but I wasn't sure about the third."

Ruth, who lives in Huddersfield, has never been to school. Her father, Harry Lawrence, a computer programmer, gave up his job when Ruth was five to educate her at home. Her mother, Sylvia, who also works with computers, is the family breadwinner.

Harry Lawrence explained that Ruth enjoyed not only mathematics, but also English, history, geography and other subjects. She began to read at four and started academic subjects at five.

"Ruth enjoys serious conversation with adults." her father said. He does not think she works harder than other children of her age. She concentrates on what she enjoys. Especially mathematics "She rarely watches television but she plays the piano and has other interests." he explained.

If she does well at St Hugh's, Ruth expects to become a professor of mathematics - an ambition she may achieve while she is still very young. The Lawrence family were very happy last night when they heard the news. They are planning to move to Oxford in October.
