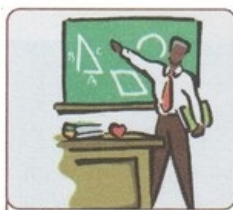

He **isn't/ is not** a student.  
She **isn't/ is not** a student.  
It **isn't/ is not** a bird  
We **aren't/ are not** students.  
You **aren't/ are not** students.  
They **aren't/ are not** students.

#### Interrogative

**Am** I in class 7?  
**Are** you in class 7?  
**Is** he in class 7?  
**Is** she in class 7?  
**Is** it a bird?  
**Are** we in class 7?  
**Are** you in class 7?  
**Are** they in class 7?
