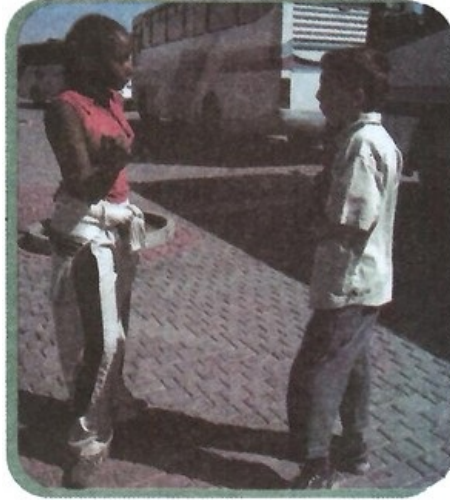
Sheila : Oh, no she doesn't. She prefers the train. How about you ? which do you prefer,
