May = permission	Have to = necessity
A: <i>May</i> I go home? I don't feel well.	A: <i>Do</i> I <i>have to</i> make an appointment?
B: You <i>may</i> go now, but come tomorrow; you <i>may not</i> miss the test.	B: No, you <i>don't</i> / <i>don't have to</i> , but you <i>have to</i> be here at 3:00.
